

## - WINNING NAMES AND THEIR EXPLANATIONS -

### Street Parallel to JMP

---

#### Yosemite Drive

- This continues the theme set by John Muir, named for the noted naturalist and environmentalist. John Muir loved Yosemite and was instrumental in making it a national park.

### "Transit Loop"

---

#### Shoreline Loop

- This is the main drag along the waterfront and the only street where the water isn't blocked by buildings or the land mass of the Hercules Point.

### "Edge Street"

---

#### Park Street

- A continuation of "Park Street" crossing "Railroad Avenue".

### "Walk Street"

---

#### Tamalpais Trail

- The street will provide a great view of Mount Tamalpais across the Bay.

### "Key Street"

---

#### Shorehaven Drive

- A street adjacent to the Bay and consistent with the nautical theme of the project.

### Railroad Plaza

---

#### Powder Works Plaza

- In recognition of the Hercules Powder Works factory that once existed on the site.

### Civic Plaza

---

#### Hercules Plaza

- A plaza named after the City of Hercules and a reference of civic pride.

### Creekside Park

---

#### Edgewater Park

- A park that will be located along the water's edge.
